Goal: To make a music video that features the graduating 4th grade class of 2020. Students will record themselves singing and send the video to Mrs. Walle. At the end there will be a 'virtual performance'

where everyone is together like the example picture below.



Song: "I'll Think of You"

Assignment:

Step 1: Listen to the song "I'll Think of You" while reading the lyrics.

Click here for Song lyrics and Mp3 (Mrs. Walle's Music website)

Step 2: Practice singing along to the song until you know the lyrics very well. You might need to practice for a few days.

Step 3: Get Ready to record yourself singing.

You will need:

Headphones

Listening/Watching video device (plug your headphone into this)

Recording device (iphone, camera, ipad, computer)

A very quiet room (not outside)

Step 4: Watch the "Instructions to Record Yourself" video once so you know what to do.

Step 5: Record yourself singing while watching "Instructions to Record" video

- Face is looking right at the recording device.
- Headphone is plugged into the same device as the Video.
- Take one headphone off of your ear so you can hear your own voice.
- Your camera should be horizontal like this:



Step 6: SAVE your video as "NAME WB MUSIC" with NAME being your first name (For example: Jamie WB Music)
